Medications in Nephrotic Syndrome: Mycophenolate

When do we use mycophenolate?

In children who may not get better with steroids or other medications. have repeated relapses, or have side effects to steroids

It may take several weeks for you to see a difference in your (your child's) condition.

How do I (does my child) take mycophenolate?

At the

same time

of day, at

apart

For as long as the team tells you, even if you (your child) feel(s) better

least 12 hours

Do not change dose unless advised



Precautions on mycophenolate



Watch for signs of infection



Avoid antacids, iron or magnesium supplements



Do not receive Tell your healthcare vaccines without team if you (your child) talking to your team may be pregnant



- If you (your child) miss(es) a dose, take it as soon as you remember
- If it is time for the next dose, skip the missed dose
- Never take two doses to make up for a missed dose




If you (your child) throw(s) up:

< 30 min. — repeat dose once

> 30 min. — do not repeat; call team for advice

Mycophenolate may cause birth defects if taken at time of conception or during pregnancy.




HELP PREVENT THESE SIDE EFFECTS BY TAKING MYCOPHENOLATE WITH **FOOD EVERY TIME**

Contact your healthcare team if you (your child) experience(s) these symptoms:

Multiple watery bowel movements or upset stomach Weakness or loss of energy

Seek immediate medical care if you have (your child has) any of these side effects:



The following side effects are very rare at the doses given for nephrotic syndrome. They include skin cancer and gastrointestinal bleeding.
