Who Can Participate?

Individuals aged 12 months to 60 years who meet one of the following criteria:

1. Have a genetic diagnosis of PWS **OR**
2. Have no prior diagnosis of a neurodevelopmental condition **OR**
3. Have a genetic diagnosis associated with neurodevelopment/intellectual disability e.g., Down Syndrome, Angelman Syndrome
