

TOCS Scoring Instructions

Scoring of individual items:

- Far less often -3
- Less often -2
- Slightly less often -1
- Average amount of time 0
- Slightly more often 1
- More often 2
- Far more often 3

Score of 2 or 3 = OCD symptom

Overall Scores:

TOCS OCD Total score: sum of all items (1-21)

TOCS OCD Symptom Total: total number of items (1-21) with a score of 2 or 3 **TOCS OCD Max Average**: highest raw average score for any given dimension

Subscale Scores:

- Cleanliness/Contamination Dimension Score: sum of items 13-17
 Cleanliness/Contamination Dimension Symptom Total: sum of items 13-17 with scores 2 or Cleanliness/Contamination Dimension Average: average of items 13-17
- Symmetry/Ordering Dimension Score: sum of items 7, 10-12
 Symmetry/Ordering Dimension Symptom Total: sum of items 7, 10-12 with scores 2 or 3
 Symmetry/Ordering Dimension Symptom Average: average of items 7, 10-12
- Counting/Checking Dimension Score: sum of items 2-3, 6
 Counting/Checking Dimension Symptom Total: sum of items 2-3, 6 with scores 2 or 3
 Counting/Checking Dimension Average: average of items 2-3, 6
- Rumination Dimension Score: sum of items 4-5
 Rumination Dimension Symptom Total: sum of items 4-5 with scores 2 or 3
 Rumination Dimension Average: average of items 4-5
- Superstition Dimension Score: sum of items 9, 20-21
 Superstition Dimension Symptom Total: sum of items 9, 20-21 with scores 2 or 3
 Superstition Dimension Average: average of items 9, 20-21
- Hoarding Dimension Score: sum of items 18-19
 Hoarding Dimension Symptom Total: sum of items 18-19 with scores 2 or 3
 Hoarding Dimension Average: average of items 18-19
