

Key Updates

Project 1: Quality Indicators for Transition from Paediatric to Adult Care

What's been happening in the last 4 months:

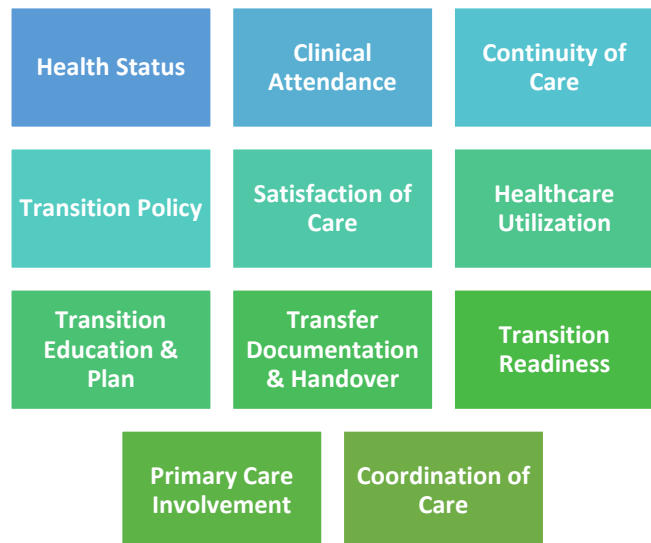


Online-Modified Delphi (OMD), January 20 – March 8:

- A total of 170 experts in transition, health administrators (41), caregivers (36), healthcare providers (59), and youth (34) were invited to participate.
- Participants rated and discussed 21 quality indicators on their importance and feasibility for measuring transition success.
- Two identical panels completed the three-round process with a completion rate of 61% (105/170) in round 3.

Hybrid Consensus Meeting, May 27, 9 am – 4 pm:

- Co-investigators and iKT panel members came together to review the OMD results.
- 4 indicators recommended for inclusion, 15 for further discussion, and 2 for exclusion were brought to the meeting.
- The consensus meeting was filled with rich group discussions, with a focus on feasibility concerns raised by OMD participants.
- **We prioritized a final list of 11 indicators!**



What's coming up:

- An **evaluation study** of our iKT approach is underway with iKT panel members. Simran Jawanda, a 3rd-year medical student, will be leading this sub-project this summer.
- Additional analysis of the OMD data will focus on comparing and contrasting the different expert group perspectives, with a particular emphasis on youth.
- The manuscript to report the findings from the OMD and the consensus meeting is currently in progress. The final draft will be distributed for review in August/September.
- Exciting News! Our project will be presented at the **IAAH World Congress on Adolescent Health** this November in Montego Bay, Jamaica.
- Three abstracts have also been submitted to the **European Symposium on Transition**, set for September in Paris, France.

Project 2: Scoping review on patient, caregiver and knowledge user engagement in consensus-building healthcare initiatives

What's been happening in the last 4 months:

- Extraction and categorization of quantitative and qualitative data are now complete on 177 articles.

What's coming up:

- Data analysis has now begun and will continue until July.
- We are looking forward to sharing the preliminary data with you and getting your feedback at the **next scoping review subcommittee meetings** in July.
- We are aiming to submit the final manuscript to a peer-reviewed journal by the end of the summer.
